MEETING AGENDA: Amended the agenda by removing Rahn Savage, Needham made motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Van Maanen. All ayes, Motion carried.

MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING: A motion was made by Needham and seconded by Comegys to approve the September meeting minutes. All ayes, Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS: ELECTION: Reminder to get out and vote on November 4. Mayor and 3 council seats will be on the ballot.

TRUCK QUOTES: 3 quotes were presented: GMC: \$50490.00, Ford: 48500.00 and Chevy: 46327.40. Needham made motion to approve the Chevy quote along with the new blade and sander quote package for total of 67,849.00, seconded by Comegys, all ayes, motion carried. Will need to determine which way to handle current truck and equipment, what will trade in be or best to sell outright.

WATER TOWER SERVICE UPGRADE: Comegys made motion to approve bid from JETCO along with the 3 yr Omni-Site Contract, seconded by Van Maanen. All ayes, Motion Carried. The bid consists of Tower Level Panel, Level/Pressure Transmitter, Omni-Beacon Alarm Notification System along with Jetco Services for \$20100.00 and the 3 yr OmniSite contract of \$378.

SIDEWALK SOUTH OF BALL PARK: Sidewalk needs repaired. City is willing to pay for half the cost. Homeowner needs to be contacted. Item tabled.

RESOLUTION 101325: Van Maanen made motion to approve Resolution 101325 approving ClerkBooks End of Year changes, Comegys seconded, all ayes, Motion Carried.

MAINTENACE: Clerk Arthur reported sewer & water in compliance. Hrydro Kleen submitted a bid to camera the lines by the ball park to further research the excess water issue. \$440 per hour with a 4 hr minimum. Needham made motion to approve the bid up to 8 hrs, seconded by Comegys, all ayes, motion carried. A quote was received from Tank Maintenance Solutions for \$168,287.00 to repaint the exterior of the water tower with an optional add on price

of \$42276.00 to blast and paint the interior. The warranty would be for a 2 year period. After discussion of the price and warranty, council tabled this item and will conduct more research to see if the water tower is needed. Due to this decision, Needham made motion to rescind the previous Jetco bid for the Water tower service upgrade, seconded by Comegys, all ayes, motion carried.
